



Summary

International Confederation of Futebol de Salão (ICFDS) is based at Garforth Town Football Club.

e2e at ICFDS uses football as a way of giving young people the basic skills needed to prepare them for progression into Apprenticeships, College or Employment.

At ICFDS you will be able to work towards your own chosen goals with regular one-to-one contact with your tutor in order to keep you on track. You will have regular meetings with Connexions PAs about your chosen progression route.

All young people on e2e at ICFDS are eligible for EMA and you will receive a weekly bus or train pass which entitles you to free travel throughout West Yorkshire.

Training

At ICFDS you will take part in a mixture of classroom based and outdoor activities.

In the classroom you will be able to work towards nationally recognised qualifications including:

- OCR Functional Skills in English, Maths and ICT
- ASDAN Award in Employability
- ASDAN Award in Personal and Social Development.

Outdoor activities including football and general fitness at ICFDS equip you with vital skills needed for progression such as teamwork, communication, improved self confidence and problem solving. In addition to this you will have the opportunity to work towards gaining the

- CSLA (Community Sports Leadership Award) NVQ Level 1.

Vocational Experience

As well as the opportunity to gain a vocational qualification through the CSLA (Community Sports Leadership Award) NVQ Level 1, all young people have the chance to gain work experience in a number of roles within the football club including Brazilian Soccer School Leeds which specialise in football coaching and after school clubs for children aged 5-16 years old.
