The JHP entry to employment programme is designed to help young people move forward into employment, further training or college by offering structured support, guidance and vocational opportunities. How the programme develops is entirely down to each individual young person as the course chosen will be tailored to their individual needs.

We work with learners of varying ability and offer a structured level of support depending on individual circumstances and barriers. At JHP we believe that each learner has the right to choose their own progression route and offer each young person support to help them achieve their goals.



Training

Each young person will have the opportunity to achieve formal qualifications both in personal and social development and occupational areas.

Skills and techniques offered:-

- CV writing and job search
- Developing maths, English and communication skills
- Team Work and confidence building
- Interview skills
- Work experience placements

Social skills are also developed through the various specialist sessions that are on offer to learners such as

- Drug Awareness
- Sexual Health
- Health and Safety
- Equal Opportunities
- Fire Safety

Certificate in adult literacy and numeracy from entry level to level two are available for all learners on e2e at JHP.
