



Summary

Our Motor Vehicle Studies programme is designed to give young people with no previous mechanics experience a realistic look at a range of different careers in the motor trade. All students work towards a nationally recognised mechanics qualification, a Health and Safety qualification as well as English, Maths and ICT and are given the chance to utilise these at one of our many real-world placements. Following the completion of the programme young people are able to progress into an Apprenticeship, employment or college.



Training

Our Motor Vehicle Studies programme is workshop based; students are taught in a practical skills based environment designed to match a real working garage as closely as possible. This means they are able to gain the real skills needed to have a successful career in the motor trade. Workshop sessions are then supported with technical classes where practical skills are turned into a solid working knowledge of motor systems. All training is relaxed and taught in a safe environment where all abilities are given the freedom to shine.

Vocational Experience

Through the skills and underpinning knowledge gained in the workshop and technical sessions of the Motor Vehicle Studies programme students are able to access a real working environment at one of our many work placements. Here students will be working in a real-life environment, working on customer cars and gaining experience that hugely increases their employability chances. This is a target for all young people on the programme and is based on both the learner and placement being comfortable with the arrangements.
