The National Youth train Programme is designed to be flexible and adaptable so that it can be used in a wide range of situations and settings and with young people of all ages and abilities. It is made up of bite-sized taster units, which can be achieved in 10 hours of guided learning time, alongside more in-depth, subject specific units, which can be achieved in 20 or 30 hours of learning.
